UNITED NATIONS MONITORING VERIFICATION AND INSPECTION COMMISSION (UNMOVIC) VACANCY NEWSLETTER®

The United Nations Monitoring, Verification and Inspection Commission (UNMOVIC) was created through the adoption of Security Council resolution 1284 of 17 December 1999. UNMOVIC replaced the former UN Special Commission (UNSCOM) and continued with the mandate to verify Iraq's compliance with its obligation to be rid of its weapons of mass destruction (chemical, biological weapons and missiles with a range of more than 150 km), and to operate a system of ongoing monitoring and verification to ascertain that Iraq did not reacquire the same weapons prohibited to it by the Security Council.

UNMOVIC INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

The UNMOVIC also provide opportunities for students enrolled in a graduate programme to undertake an internship at the United Nations Headquarters in New York, Geneva, Vienna, Nairobi, Addis Ababa, Bangkok, Beirut and Santiago.

The purpose of the UNMOVIC Internship Programme is:

This is to provide a framework by which graduate and post-graduate students from diverse academic backgrounds may be assigned to United Nations Offices where their educational experience can be enhanced through practical work assignments. To expose them to the work of the United Nations.

To gain experience in the work of the Organization with the objective of deepening their knowledge and understanding of the United Nations' goals, principles and activities. To provide UN offices with the assistance of highly qualified students specialized in various professional fields.

To qualify for the Internship Programme, the following conditions must be met:

1. Applicants must be enrolled in a degree programme in a graduate school (second university degree or higher) at the time of application and during the internship;

2. Applicants pursuing their studies in countries where higher education is not divided into undergraduate and graduate stages must have completed at least four years of full-time studies at a university or equivalent institution towards the completion of a degree.
