BIVARIATE HIGH-LEVEL EXCEEDANCE AND THE CHEN-STEIN THEOREM IN
GENOMICS MULTIPLE HYPOTHESIS TESTING PERSPECTIVES¹
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In genomic studies, generally the genes are neither independent nor marginally identically distributed, though in microarray studies and DNA/RNA SNP models, often they are assumed to be independent and identically distributed. A version of the ChenStein theorem on Poisson approximation for dependent binary variables has been adopted for a mathematical justification of this approach in a general genomic setup.
